EVS (Environmental Studies):

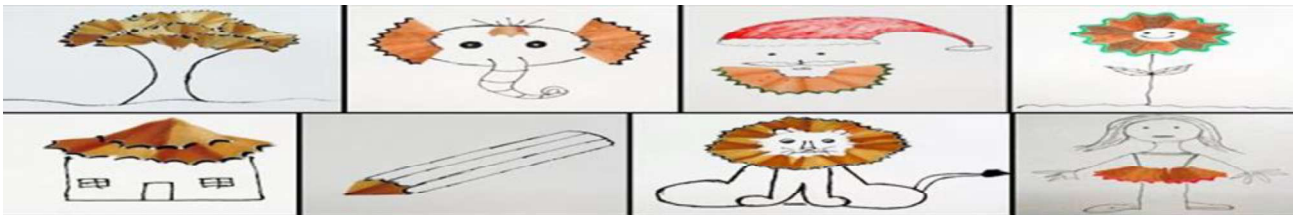
Create a family tree and write few lines about your family. (Make a scrapbook)
